## 10 Acre Farm Water-Free

**Water for growers. Organic vegetables for families. California jobs and fresh local food.**

- 1. Free water support for farms 10 acres or less.** MACA will create a basic irrigation support program for qualifying small farms so water cost is not the reason local food production shuts down in California.
- 2. Organic vegetables for California families.** Participating farms will grow approved organic vegetables and fresh produce so more Californians can buy local, healthy, and state-grown food at stable prices.
- 3. Guaranteed purchase and price protection.** MACA will establish a state purchase guarantee and floor-price system for selected crops so small farmers have a buyer, predictable income, and less market risk.
- 4. Planned crop targets by region.** The state will set crop priorities by county and season to match water conditions, local demand, school nutrition needs, and California food-security goals.
- 5. Simple reporting and accountability.** Farms of 10 acres or less will report monthly sales and annual revenue so the state can measure production, payments, jobs created, and contribution to California growth.
- 6. Jobs in every farming county.** MACA will target at least two California jobs for every 10 acres supported through growing, harvesting, packing, delivery, farm services, and local food distribution.
- 7. Keep food production in California.** MACA will help California produce more of its own vegetables at home instead of depending so heavily on outside supply, long-haul transport, and unstable prices.
